UPCOMING SESSIONS:

- **Educational Opportunities for Clients**

July 19 at 10:00 a.m.

- This session will include a panel from Missouri Western State University, North Central Missouri College, St. Joseph School District Adult Education and St. Joseph Youth Alliance who will share about educational opportunities for clients. The objective of this session is to educate case workers and agency staff on a variety of educational opportunities that may benefit their clients, ranging from high school equivalency to certificate or associate degree programs.

- **Resources 101**

August 2 at 10:00 a.m.

- These sessions will be offered on a quarterly basis. Each session is geared to new agency staff and will provide them with a base understanding of agencies, resources and services available in the St. Joseph community.

- **Employment and Workforce Training Programs for Clients**

- This session will include a panel from several agencies that provide workforce training, job seeking assistance and other employment supports for clients and community members. The objective of this session is to educate case workers and agency staff on a variety of employment and workforce development opportunities that may benefit their clients.
